## **Tournament Information:**

- All preliminary round-robin matches will be 2 games. All playoff matches will be best of 3 games.
- Placement will be decided by total number of games won. If two or more teams are tied at the end of the preliminary round, the following criteria will be applied, in order, according to the Volleyball Canada tie-breaking procedure:
  - 1. The team having the best ratio of won/lost matches, considering matches between the tied teams, will be ranked higher;
  - 2. The team having the best ratio of won/lost games, considering matches played between the tied teams, will be ranked higher;
  - 3. The team having the best ratio of won/lost games, considering all matches of the round, will be ranked higher;
  - 4. The team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering games played between the tied teams, will be ranked higher;
  - 5. The team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering all games played during the round, will be ranked higher;
  - 6. Toss of coin.
- Teams will receive a 5-5 minute warm-up prior to their first daily match and a 3-3 minute warm-up for all remaining matches. Please make sure your team is ready to play so that we do not fall behind schedule.
- Each team will be given their own team room for changing and storing possessions. A tournament host
  will welcome you, be available to you for the weekend, and be responsible for locking and unlocking your
  room.
- There will be a coaches' room available during the tournament with light snacks and refreshments.
- There will be a full concession at the school throughout the entire tournament.
