



High School Driver Education

SGI Customer Number, photo capture and Online Testing

A SGI customer number is required to enrol in high school driver education. This can be done well in advance of being enrolled in driver education. Changes effective Feb 24, 2020 also require a photo to be captured when the customer number is issued. The photo being captured at the time of the initial visit is to protect the identity of our customers. This makes the ID more secure and improves our ability to prevent fraudulent activity and identity theft.

Visit a motor licence issuer to:

Get yourself a customer number

- Bring two pieces of original identification to establish your full legal name, complete date of birth and signature (e.g., Canadian birth certificate/Canadian passport and Saskatchewan health card). Visit www.sgi.sk.ca for more information.
- Bring the Signature Form for First Time Drivers. If section A of this form is completed by a parent, it can be used to prove residency. If section C is completed by a parent, it can be used to verify a first time driver's signature.
- Once your identification is established, you will receive a Personal Identification Document containing your customer number. Verify this for accuracy and ensure all information including: height, gender (if you choose to note this on your id) and eye colour are accurate. Once the customer number is assigned you receive an SGI non-driver photo ID card in the mail. The first non-driver photo ID card is provided free of charge.
- Present your identification document or non-driver photo ID card to your high school driving instructor. Note: If you currently have an SGI non-driver photo ID, you do not need to visit a motor licence issuer.

Register a valid email address (only required for online testing)

Note: if you currently have a SGI non-driver photo ID, you can register an email address by calling the SGI Customer Service Centre in Regina (306) 775-6900 or toll free 1-800-667-9868

Online versus paper testing

Many schools offer online testing for your Class 7 learners knowledge exam as an alternative to paper testing. Features of online testing include:

- colourful graphics to clarify the meaning of questions
- immediate feedback tells you if you're right or wrong
- instant scoring confirms whether you passed or failed

After you register an email address you can now create a [MySGI account](#) and write your tests online during the high school program.

General Information

Each student will receive instruction in Driver Education for a minimum of 30 hours of classroom instruction and 6 hours in a car behind the wheel. The car to be used has dual-brake control and is insured for all who ride in it.

The 6 hours of 'behind the wheel,' in car instruction only provides a very basic level of driver training. It is most important, therefore, that the student be allowed to practice in the family car until he/she has mastered what has been taught. It is in this area that parents have a great part to play in the satisfactory completion of the training.

Your attention is drawn to the fact that students in the program will hold a valid learner's license. All students under the age of 16 with a learner's license must be accompanied by a parent, legal guardian, or authorized instructor who holds a current, valid operator's license. Anyone accompanying a student driver must have held an operator's license for a minimum of one year.
